

Renovation training fields


- 1st field will be renovated in April
- 2nd field will be renovated in May
- Scrape top layer / remove old top layer
- Sweep
- Desso grassmaster by jigging the rakes up the fibers
- Vertidraining at a depth of + 22cm
- Sowing by Vredo, with 100% RPR Barenbrug
- Strained with + 8m3 sand of sand


- Location: Philips Stadium

- First time that Fieldmanagers of football organizations with artificial grass were present, a lot of interest among these clubs for converting artificial grass to natural grass!











- If necessary, drag dew
- Length mowing, with Dennis mower 2.3cm á 2.4cm
- Brushing for cutting out in width (optional)
- Mow width, with Dennis mower 2.3cm á 2.1cm
- Lines main field, with stamp carriage in two directions (for a nice smooth white color)
- Placing competition goals + placing reserve targets for the w-up
- Place corner flags







Matchday during wintertime

- Removing any covers
- Removing the SGL Units
- If necessary, drag dew
- Length mowing, with Dennis mower (optional / weather dependent) 2.5cm á 2.4cm
- Brushing for cutting out in width (optional / weather dependent)
- Width mowing, with Dennis mower 2.4cm á 2.3cm
- Lines main field, with sprayer in one direction
- Placing competition goals + placing reserve targets for the w-up
- Place corner flags







- The removal of any covers
- Removing the SGL Units
 - LU440 9pc.
 - MU50 2pc.
 - MU18 2pc.

- Length mowing, with Dennis mower (optional / weather dependent) 2.5cm á 2.4cm
- Width mowing, with Dennis mower 2.4cm á 2.3cm
- Straight mowing (separation from light to dark) mowing by means of to cut along rope









- Lines main field in the summer with the stamping carriage
- Ready-made paint
- Lines main field in the winter with the spray trailer
- Dilute with water
- Turning off ropes to obtain straight lines
- Tailor-made ropes
- In concrete edge along the artificial grass strip his reference points measured to the rope confirm







- Placing match / competition goals
- Place reserve targets
- Place corner flags







Matchday Sunday - 14.30





Matchday Sunday - 15.15 halftime

- Chek captain for water on the pitch
- If so; put irrigationsystem on
- If not; helping rest of the crew repair damage on the pitch







Sunday 16.15 end of the game

- Discard match targets + remove corner flags
- Using circular mowers to clean up all parts that have come loose from the field
- Scarifying, brushing for "low-fleece" or sowing with RPR or SOS, temperature-dependent (optional / weather-dependent)
- Repair the damage
- Replace SGL Units on the field and connect + MU50 and LU50
- Replace any covers if necessary
- Clean machines





Stadium pitch measuring equipment

- SGL- boxes
 - Moisture content
 - Light intensity
 - EC content
 - Soil temperature
 - Outside temperature
 - Leaf wet
 - Humidity




